Emergency Planning Information

The *Emergency Response Guidelines* (found in the Safe Guide appendix) include general procedures for managing issues related to missing persons, intruders, evacuations, medical emergencies and parent/guardian late for pick-ups. Situation	Procedure to follow
Missing Person	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Notify Ontario Science Centre Staff in person or by using red emergency phone located throughout the OSC. 2. Provide a description of the missing person and where she was last seen. 3. Retrace steps with OSC Staff. <p>(Also see appendix)</p>
Evacuation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Gather group together, get outdoor garments if possible and proceed to emergency exit. 2. Report to Ontario Science Centre Staff if whole group is accounted for. If not, see missing person instructions above. 3. Wait outside for further instructions <p>(Also see appendix)</p>
Intruder	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alert Ontario Science Centre Staff in person or by using red emergency phones located throughout the OSC. 2. Report location and description of intruder. <p>(Also see appendix)</p>
Medical Emergency	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alert Ontario Science Centre Staff in person or by using red emergency phone located throughout the OSC. 2. Provide details of location and type of medical emergency. 3. Begin first aid if trained in procedures. 4. Ontario Science Centre Security Personnel will arrive and attend to emergency. 5. EMS will arrive if contacted by OSC Security Personnel (depending on the severity of situation). <p>(Also see appendix)</p>

Other Emergency Planning Considerations:

1. Ontario Science Centre premises are monitored 24 hours/day, externally and internally, by Closed-Circuit TV,

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alarms and computer access security systems.

2. Ontario Science Centre Security Personnel patrol and monitor the premises 24 hours/day.
3. There are three OSC Security Personnel plus Sleepover Staff on-site throughout the duration of a Sleepover event, and all are trained in first aid procedures.
4. EMS is easily accessible.
5. All Sleepover participants are oriented in fire alarm/emergency procedures.
