Brush up on your space sciences vocabulary

What you'll need:

- Pens
- Scissors
- Scrap paper
- A headband or bandana for each player

Game setup:


1. Cut your paper into 28 rectangles.
2. Write one "clue card" word from the list below on each rectangle. Leave enough blank space below the word to tuck the card into your headband. Try to write the words as clearly as possible, using large handwriting.

Printout option: Instead of creating your own cards, you can print the clue cards on page 2 and cut them out.

How to play:

1. Each player puts on their headband across their forehead.
2. The first player puts a clue card in their headband with the clue word facing outward so the other player(s) can see the word. No peeking at your own word!
3. The first player asks the other players yes/no questions about their secret science word. For example, "Am I a planet?", "Am I a living thing?" or "Am I made of rock?" There's no limit to the number of questions the player can ask before guessing what their clue is.
Tip: Start with big, general questions, then try to get more specific.
4. Players take turns playing with different clue cards.

With this game, there is no scorekeeping. Everybody wins!
