This social story shows what the Science Centre looks like, where the front and rear entrances are and how individuals will get around due to required maintenance. A social story is a tool used to model sample social interactions by giving a brief description of a situation using appropriate social cues, the perspectives of others and a recommended appropriate response. We have created this one to help individuals with disabilities, including neurodevelopmental disorders, prepare for a visit to the Science Centre.

Visiting the Ontario Science Centre


The next time you visit, you may notice that the Science Centre looks a little different right now.

Here is the front entrance of the Science Centre.





Due to required maintenance, the Science Centre is using two entrances: the front entrance and the rear entrance.





You will see signs directing you to the shuttle boarding area that will take you to the rear entrance for exhibit halls. If you're seeing a film, you'll use the front entrance.

The shuttle will pull up and you will board a bus that looks similar to this one.



After you board the shuttle, it will take you to the rear entrance of the Science Centre. This photo shows the shuttle going down the hill.







After a short ride, you will arrive at the rear entrance of the Science Centre.






When you get off the shuttle, you will see the rear entrance of the Science Centre.

Here is where you will board the shuttle at the rear entrance.




Once you are on the shuttle, it will take you back up the hill and drop you off near the front entrance.
